# MIDLAND CEMETERY HISTORY

Established circa 1795 as the resting place of slaves, those born into slavery and died free. It holds the remains of veterans of early wars such as the United States Colored Troops, Buffalo Soldiers, Tuskegee Airmen, soldiers of World War I and II along with Korean

War veterans.

Nestled on the old Kelker farm in Swatara Township on Kelker Street and Cole Alley (behind the Steelton-Highspire High School), this now plush green site with its white stones protruding from the earth has a story to tell. This site has become noted for its historical value, a place of peace, tranquility and beauty where every headstone is a book of history.

The Friends of Midland, is a 501 (c) 3 organization. Formed in June 1993 for the sole purpose of restoration, preservation with education of the Midland Cemetery. The Group has worked hard to expose the history of the cemetery by inviting historians, colleges and community to the site.
